

Commercial Kitchen Policy

Very Important

Our commercial kitchen is closely inspected and monitored by the State Board of Health. Violations could result in loss of use of the kitchen and the very undesirable potential of bad media attention.

Our commercial kitchen is a school lunch kitchen and there may not be room in the freezer or refrigerator on the day you need the kitchen. (If that is the case we will work with you the best we can to accommodate your needs.) From 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., on days when school is in session, the kitchen is not available for meal preparation other than for the school hot lunch program. During these hours, the kitchen refrigeration or storage are only available when an advanced request is made to the full time kitchen staff. Specific times parameters are required.

Because of the likely potential of overload to electrical circuits, no outside equipment requiring power is allowed in the commercial kitchen.

There must be at least one person from the approved person list in attendance from the beginning to the end of event.

Please make sure that all kitchen gadgets stay in the kitchen.

If you wish to donate any items please leave a note stating what you donated and who you are.

The Board of Health requires that no food prepared at home may be sold to the public from this kitchen!

Please do not use the school food/drinks for your event.

Please do not use the schools plastic ware/plates/cups.

This kitchen is only available for church/school functions at this time. If the policy should change we will update at that time.
